NTST500 (3)
Interpreting the New Testament
An introduction to the literature and interpretation of the New Testament. Available only to students who lack New Testament Survey (or equivalent) in their undergraduate studies.

NTST606 (3-4)
Formation and History of the New Testament
Development and history of the New Testament canon and/or its text, English translation, and publication. Topic announced in advance. Repeatable.

NTST677 (3-4)
Seminar in New Testament Issues
Topics announced in the Class Schedule. Repeatable. Admission for non-doctoral students by permission of professor.

EXEGESIS

Passing the Greek qualifying examination at the intermediate level is a prerequisite for enrolling in New Testament exegesis courses except NTST550.

NTST550 (3-4)
Exegesis of the English New Testament
Topics identical to NTST600-level exegesis courses (except NTST678). The same subject cannot be repeated on both levels. Does not presuppose Greek proficiency nor count toward MDiv core requirements or emphases, nor the MA major in New Testament. Repeatable with a different subject area.

NTST605 (3-4)
Gospels
The Gospel(s) to be studied are announced in advance. Repeatable.

NTST609 (3-4)
Pauline Writings
The letter(s) of Paul to be studied are announced in advance. Repeatable.

NTST643 (3-4)
General Epistles
The epistle(s) chosen from among James, 1 Peter, 2 Peter, Jude, and 1-3 John announced in advance. Repeatable.

NTST645 (3-4)
Hebrews

NTST646 (3-4)
Studies in New Testament Exegesis
Studies in hermeneutical principles and procedures requisite to NT interpretation and/or in various sections or themes of the New Testament. Repeatable.

NTST660 (3-4)
The Acts of the Apostles

NTST675 (3-4)
The Book of Revelation

NTST678 (3-4)
Seminar in Greek Exegesis
Particular books or passages to be exegeted are announced in advance. Repeatable. Admission for non-doctoral students by permission of professor.

NTST940 (4)
Seminar in New Testament Exegesis and Hermeneutics
Exegesis in New Testament books or passages and/or studies in particular topics such as the history of New Testament exegesis and hermeneutics. Repeatable.
