

**Worship Attendance.** Students must attend worship services regularly during their program of study. Attendance is required at least once a week during the semester.

**Final Exams.** Students must pass all final exams in order to graduate. Final exams are given at the end of each semester.

**Residency Requirements.** Students must reside in the United States for a minimum of one year before enrolling in the program.

**Time Limits on Degrees.** Students must complete their program of study within a specified time limit. The time limit is determined by the number of credits required for the program.

**Transfer Credit.** Students may receive credit for courses completed at other institutions. Transfer credit is subject to approval by the faculty.

## PROGRAMS

**M.Div.** The Master of Divinity program is a two-year program of study. It is designed for students who plan to enter the ministry. The program includes courses in biblical studies, theology, and church history.

**M.A.** The Master of Arts program is a two-year program of study. It is designed for students who plan to continue their education in a graduate program. The program includes courses in biblical studies, theology, and church history.

**M.P.** The Master of Pastoral Studies program is a two-year program of study. It is designed for students who plan to enter the ministry. The program includes courses in biblical studies, theology, and church history.

**M.S.** The Master of Science program is a two-year program of study. It is designed for students who plan to continue their education in a graduate program. The program includes courses in biblical studies, theology, and church history.

**M.P.S.** The Master of Professional Studies program is a two-year program of study. It is designed for students who plan to enter the ministry. The program includes courses in biblical studies, theology, and church history.

## MDiv: Master of Divinity

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The Master of Divinity program is a two-year program of study. It is designed for students who plan to enter the ministry. The program includes courses in biblical studies, theology, and church history.
